- 1- Parenting includes assisting families as they support children as students and assisting school personnel in understanding families.
- 2 - Communicating - School-to-home and home-to-school communication is provided to families about school programs and their child's progress.
- 3 - Volunteering - Efforts are made to involve as many people as possible as volunteers, redefining the term volunteer to include all those who support school goals and childrens' learning any way, any time.
- 4 - Learning at Home - Involving families in learning what their children are learning and how they are learning.
- 5 - Decision Making - Including families as participants in school decisions
- 6 - Collaborating with the Community - Coordinating community resources and services for students, families, and the schools
